

# WHO QUALIFIES?

To be eligible for the program, your household must meet the following criteria:

**Homeless Status:** Must meet the definition of “Homeless” per the Emergency Housing Program Policy.

**Income Limits:** Household income must be at or below 80% of the Snohomish County low-income limits for your family size.

**Complete Application:** Signed by all household members aged 18 and older.

**Parenting Plan:** If you have minors in the household, provide a copy of your court-ordered parenting plan (a declaration form is available if you do not have one).

**UA Requirement:** All adult household members must submit and pass a Urinalysis (UA) within 24 hours of receiving a referral.

# FINDING STABILITY

The Emergency Housing Program is designed to provide eligible households with safe, temporary hotel housing for up to 90 days. We don't just provide a roof, we offer a helping hand. Through the TTHD Wellness Program, you will receive dedicated supportive services to help you transition into stable housing.

# PROGRAM INELIGIBILITY

An application cannot be approved if:

- The household is over the income limit.
- The Head of Household is excluded from the Reservation.
- The Head of Household has a history of fraud or misrepresentation with TTHD.
- Any Household member who has outstanding debts due to hotel damages under this program. (Note: You may regain eligibility by entering into a payment agreement and signing up for general welfare deductions to repay the debt).

PLEASE NOTE: *Failure to submit a UA or sign the Authorization for Release of Information for the CDACD is deemed a Positive Drug Screen or Positive UDS (Urine Drug Screen).*

## HOW IT WORKS



### STEP 1: Apply

Submit your application. While everyone must meet eligibility requirements and funding must be available, applications are prioritized in the following order:

- Enrolled Tualip Tribal Members who are Veterans.
- Enrolled Tualip Tribal Members (18+) who are heads of household and/or have a family member in **bədaʔchəlh**.
- Enrolled Tualip Tribal Members (18+).
- Other Native American / Alaska Native applicants.



### STEP 2: UA Submission

Once housing staff receive your application, they will issue a UA referral. All adult members must complete the UA within 24 hours. Upon receiving negative results, you will be placed on the waitlist.



### STEP 3: Eligibility Review

Eligibility consideration is contingent upon applicants submitting requested documentation when selected for review.



### STEP 4: Enrollment Process

Eligible applicants will meet with the Intake Coordinator to:

- Review and sign the Emergency Housing Agreement.
- Receive a letter of intent, including the hotel confirmation and check-in steps.
- Review and sign the Emergency Housing Information Guide (covering rules, expectations, and hotel protocols).



### STEP 5: Hotel Check-In

You must check into your assigned hotel on the exact date you sign your agreement. Failure to check in as scheduled will result in termination from the program.



### STEP 6: Wellness Intake & Care Plan

After checking in, you will connect with our Emergency Wellness Coordinator for an intake appointment. Together, you will develop a personalized care plan with clear housing goals. Regular check-ins will help monitor your progress and connect you to vital community resources.



### STEP 7: Program Completion

Participants will check out of the hotel as soon as permanent housing is secured, or at the end of the 90-day stay (whichever comes first). TTHD will review final hotel charges; participants may be required to sign a Payback Agreement for any damages or unauthorized costs.



**PLEASE NOTE:** *Services are not immediate. When vacancies open up, applicants are selected directly from our Emergency Housing Waitlist.*
