Halloween Safety Tips:

The fun and excitement of Halloween, candy and costumes, safety can take a back seat leaving kids vulnerable to accidents. Here are a few safety tips to consider implementing this Halloween.

Masks - with all the fun and spooky masked costumes, make sure they don't block vision. If they do, maybe consider face paint instead.

Buddy System - Consider going out with a group and not letting youth go out trick-or-treating alone.

Be Seen - If you will be out in dark clothing, consider adding reflective tape, glow sticks or flashlights to help youth be seen by drivers.

Wait- Remind kids to wait until they get home eat candy. Consider tossing candy that is open and/or not age appropriate.

We are asking tenants to be aware of their gutters. As the leaves fall and winds pick-up, debris can land in the gutters and if they get full or clogged

it can cause water to back up. The weight of water and debris can break or damage the gutters. If you notice that water is spilling over the sides or that there is no drainage coming from the downspouts, please reach out to your tenant services specialist to put in a work order. Tenants are not typically charged for gutter work. Alerting tenant services on these matters will help us keep your homes safe and free from water damage.

We also want to remind tenants about winterizing the exterior of their homes by ensuring your hose bibs are in place.

Hose bibs are used to protect the outdoor faucets from freezing during cold winter months.

These covers are important to help prevent pipes from bursting and minimizing the risk of damages from expanding ice inside the pipes when temperatures drop.

Please remove your hoses after each use and replace the hose bib covers. .

Healthy Homes Updates

The Healthy Homes team has been able to complete mold remediation inspections of 47 of the 89 homes in Silver Village.

We are still accepting applications for these FREE mold remediation inspections.

On a case-by-case basis, you could be eligible for FREE mold remediation services. These could include Free basement encapsulation and Free fan upgrades.

What is basement encapsulation?

Simply put, it means sealing the basement to protect it from leaks and moisture. When drainage systems are put in place to keep water moving away from a home's foundation, basements are then often also encapsulated to protect it in case of a failure.
