In order for you to join us here at the Village of Hope you must meet 100% of this criteria list, in order for your application to be accepted. We look forward to you joining us to begin a new chapter at the Village of Hope!

- 1) ONE MEMBER OF HOUSEHOLD MUST BE A TRIBAL MEMBER
- 2) APPLICANT MUST CURRENTLY BE HOMELESS, BE HOUSED IN AN EMERGENCY SHELTER OR HAVE BEEN REFERRED FROM A COMMUNITY AGENCY SERVING HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS. (see definition below)
- 3) **Homeless Person:** means an individual living outside or in a building not meant for human habitation or which they have no legal right to occupy, in an emergency shelter, or in a temporary housing program which may include a transitional and supportive housing program if habitation time limits exist. We will not be accepting sex offenders, active users and those needing assisted living arrangements.
- 4) PRIORITY TO HOUSEHOLD WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:
 1. Households with young children
 2. Household member who has a physical disability or SSI.
- 5) MUST BE ABLE TO PASS A BACKGROUND CHECK
- 6) MUST BE ABLE TO PASS A URINALYSIS TEST
- 7) FAMILY'S ANNUAL INCOME MUST BE UNDER 30% OF THE AREA MEDIAN INCOME FOR THIRTY DAYS OR MORE.
